



VCS ADVISORY COUNCIL

Purpose and Responsibilities:

The VCS Advisory Council will be chaired by a Board Member. Advisory Committee Members make recommendations, provide information and materials to the Board of Directors. The Advisory Council's tasks and powers are delegated by and subject to the direction of the Board of Directors. In contrast to the Board of Directors, an Advisory Council does not have formal legal responsibilities or decision-making authority.

Structure:

1. The Council will consist of (from each campus) 2 Parents, 2 Students, 2 Teachers and 1 Board of Directors Member who will Chair the Council
2. Timeline and Meeting Frequency – 3 times per year

Expectations and Guidelines:

- Be informed about the VCS mission, vision and policies
- Discuss issues of concern from internal and external stakeholders
- Communicate with the BOD on issues/concerns from the VCS Community at large that need to be considered and addressed; provide suggested action steps for resolution
- Ability to listen, analyze, think strategically and creatively, and work well with people individually and in a group
- Ability to consider multiple viewpoints about controversial issues and to communicate VCS perspective effectively to the Board.
- Previous work on School Accountability Committees and/or other Committee
- Adhere to the Code of Ethic
- Able to attend 2 of 3 meetings

Timeline and Meeting Frequency:

- October 2018 – Assemble the council
- Serve for 1 years as an Advisory Council Member until May 2019 and can be elected for a 2nd term (not to exceed 2 terms)

Nomination Process:

- Complete the Nomination Form and submit to VCS Board via email by October 5, 2018 (vcsboard@vanguardclassical.org)
- Nominations will be reviewed by the Board; candidates will be chosen by the Board before October 25, 2018
