



Important Information Regarding CCCAP for Innovation Learning Families

Innovation Learning has been approved to accept Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP) payments at this site. CCCAP is administered through county departments of social/human services under the direction of the CDHS Division of Early Care and Learning. CCCAP provides help for paying for the cost of child care for children up to age 13, and for youth with special needs through age 18. It is an income-eligibility based program. Counties set individual income maximums for eligibility along with other program requirements/conditions.

Who's Eligible to receive CCCAP?

- Parents who are working, or
- Parents who are searching for a job (within State established time limits), or
- Teen parents (up to age 21) in a high school diploma or GED, Certificate, or Vocational program
- Parents needing child care for up to 48 months for post-secondary education or training (up to a 1st Bachelor's Degree or less), or
- GED, ESL, or Adult Basic Education, for up to 24 months, or
- Families receiving Colorado Works/TANF that are completing countable work activities on their Individual Responsibility Agreement.

Applicants must be under the income guidelines determined by the county the individual resides in to receive child care assistance. *Income guidelines are accurate as of January 2018 and subject to change at any time. Income requirements by county are listed below:
