In compliance with C.R.S. 22-11-401 & 402, Vanguard's BOD has formed a School Accountability Committee (SAC). The SAC consists of at least seven members including:

1. The director (principal) or their designee
2. At least one teacher who provides instruction at the school
3. At least three parents/guardians of students attending the school
4. At least one adult member of an organization of parents recognized by the school
5. At least one person from the community

The SAC understands that the number of parents should always exceed the number of another other group on the committee and should reflect the student populations that are significantly represented in the school. The committee's responsibilities include:

- Recommending priorities for spending school monies
- Submitting recommendations for the school improvement plan
- To meet at least quarterly to discuss how the school is progressing towards its goals
- To provide recommendations to the district SOC
